Compliance Status

Partially compliant

This website is partially compliant with the requirements set out in Appendix A of the UNI CEI EN 301549 standard due to the following non-conformities:

- Some interface elements and components are not fully keyboard-accessible or do not display a visible focus state.
- Not all graphic and multimedia elements are accompanied by adequate text alternatives.
- In some sections, the colour contrast between text and background is insufficient.
- Some content does not adapt properly to mobile devices or when zoomed to 200%.
- There are inconsistencies in the semantic structure of headings and content hierarchy.
- Some forms and inputs lack proper labels or are not fully navigable.
- Some links are not correctly identifiable or semantically marked.
- Tables are not always readable on mobile devices or in zoomed mode.
- Some automatic behaviours cannot be controlled by the user.
- Some content and functionalities are missing or altered in the mobile version compared to the desktop version.

The InfoCert website will be redesigned by the end of 2026. During the redesign process, efforts will be made to comply with the requirements set out in Appendix A of the UNI EN 301549 standard.
